Tripping over Hash paper and for calling ON ON when she wasn't on paper.

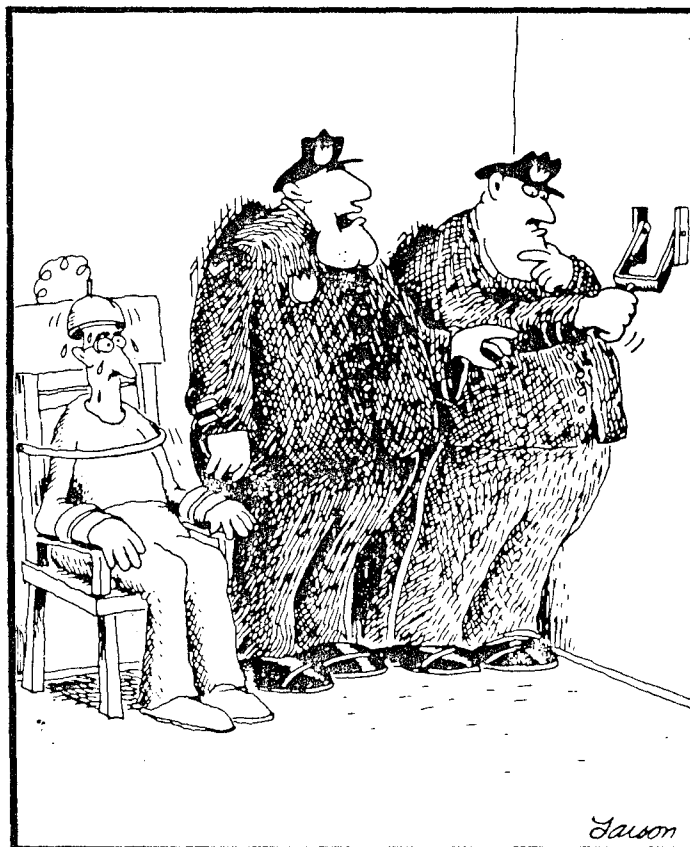
Not on paper, in other words short-cutting and then climbing up a water tower and boasting he'd been waiting 15 minutes for the pack.
