The registration bunch - Lau, Bina, Andra, Margeret, Frankie, Chris, Bill, Karen who came along early to help the committee to collect all the loot.

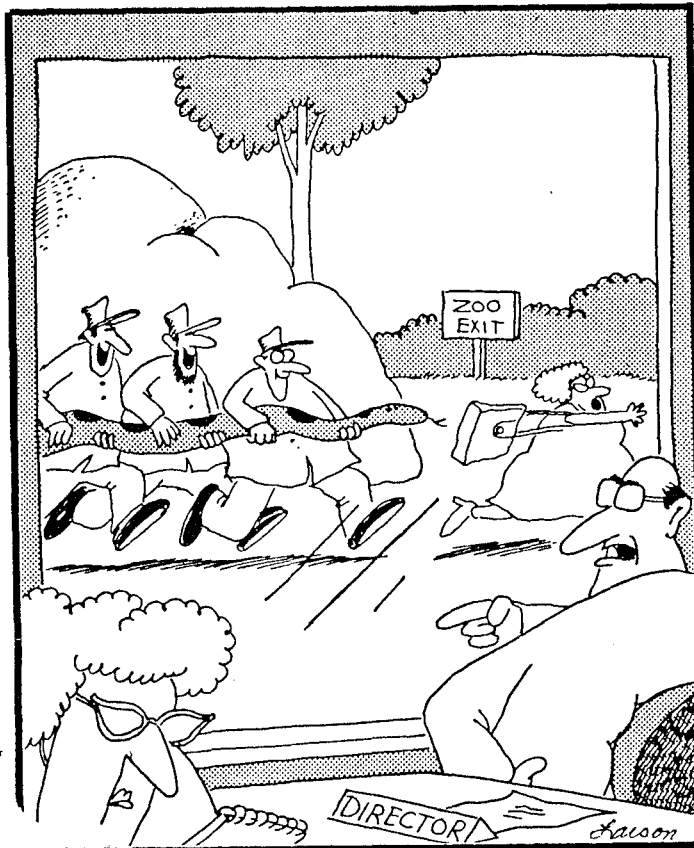
Rose Abu Bakar - who managed to find head band sponsor at the last minute and did a lot of chasing around making sure we got them in time.
